When my children were younger we had a favorite fall tradition of carving pumpkins. We would load the kids into the car and head to Memory Lane Farms to pick out the pumpkins that we thought would be good for carving. The picking of the pumpkins reminds me of how God chose each of us for His purpose. Ephesians 1:4 says, "For He chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight."

When we got home we would cut open our pumpkins and remove all the yucky pulp inside. In the same way, God removes all the yucky sins from us. Psalm 103:12 says, "As far as the east is from the west, so far has he removed our transgressions from us."

Next, we would draw a face and carve each pumpkin to change it. In the same way, Jesus transforms each of us. In 2 Corinthians 5:17 we read, "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ he is a new creation. The old has gone, the new has come." '

Finally, we put a tea light inside of the pumpkins so everyone could see its light. We too can shine the light...the light of God...by loving others. Matthew 5:16 says, "Let your light shine before men, that they may see your good deeds and praise your Father in heaven."

As you choose, remove the pulp, change, and light your pumpkins, remember how God does all of these things in you too.
