School Choice Wisconsin Town Hall Meeting

August 14, 2024 5-7pm

A team of representatives from School Choice Wisconsin came from Milwaukee, Wisconsin to present in person at our Town Hall Meeting on August 14, 2024. They joined us by invitation of the Immanuel Lutheran Church, School and Child Care Center Task Force on School Choice.

There are 12 Lutheran Church Missouri Synod day schools in the North Wisconsin District. Ten of those schools participate in the Wisconsin School Choice Program. Immanuel Lutheran Church, School and Child Care Center is one of the 2 schools currently not participating. The task force spoke with leaders in these participating schools, as well as leaders from School Choice Wisconsin, during their fact finding mission.

At the Town Hall Meeting, the team of representatives gave an overview of the Parental Choice Programs operating in the State of Wisconsin. We learned that Wisconsin was the first state to have such a program available. Currently 54,949 Wisconsin students attend private schools with a voucher. This means the schools participating in any of the 3 regional choice programs receive a state aid payment for each eligible student on behalf of the student's parent/guardian. For 2024-2025 the voucher amount is: \$10,237 for K-8th Grade, \$12,732 for 9th-12th Grade. Schools must justify the amount of money it takes to educate a student. Excess amounts received from the voucher must be kept in a reserve account.

IF Immanuel Lutheran Church, School and Child Care Center were to enter the Parental Choice Program, and we were to partner with a school already in the program, an initial number of seats chosen by us could be opened up to students currently enrolled in our school. A school entering the program can choose how many seats they want to open up to the voucher program. The Tuition Assistance funds currently allocated to those students would be freed up to be given to additional students choosing to attend our school. The current Income Eligibility Chart for the Wisconsin School Choice Programs shows a family of 4 (2 parents, 2 children) earning \$73,000 or less would qualify for a voucher.

Behind the scenes, there are audits that take place based on fall and spring enrollment, fiscal and internal control practices, and a GAAP Financial Audit. There are costs associated with these audits, applying to be in the program, and the use of a Student Information System that can interface with the State Department of Instruction (which Immanuel already uses—FastDirect).

We are a Lutheran Church Missouri Synod school. We teach the church's doctrines, the Bible, and the love of Jesus in all aspects of the school day. We follow the mission of Immanuel Lutheran Church, School and Child Care Center. This is communicated to every parent who walks through the door seeking enrollment. This would continue to be the focus, if we were to enter into the Parental Choice Program. Another Town Hall meeting will take place on September 29 during the School Pancake Breakfast. Any decisions made would require a Special Voters Assembly.
