"I miss you, seeing you, being with you, hearing you. What has happened that you are not present as you once were? It felt so good to get together, to be together. Now, it is not the same anymore. It is empty without you. What can be done about it? How do I show you I care about you?"

Have you heard someone say that lately? Are these things you, yourself are saying? How do you give care to the people in these situations? How did Jesus give care? How did He show He cared about people in the Bible? Besides His miracles, He was with them, He sat with them, listened to them, heard them out and spoke God's Word to them. The Word, which showed them their faults and the Word, which delivering God's love to them, brought them relief from all their faults with His personal forgiveness. Jesus gave them a ministry of presence.

Giving people a ministry of presence, this is what is going on here; that is how the care giving of Immanuel is growing and expanding. Along with the men who have been bringing Holy Communion to our shut in members, we now have some women who go to members just to visit with them.

As you know, giving care to people can sometimes deal with the situations and challenges they are facing; large or small. At the present time, plans are being made as to how that can be included in our care giving.

The ministry of presence, showing we care; thanks to Jesus and His care for us, is a growing ministry. Everyone of us at Immanuel is able to do this ministry in one way or another; in our own unique style.
